#### CALL TO ORDER

The Wilco Board of Control met for a special meeting on Tuesday, December 1, 2015, at Wilco Area Career Center. The meeting was called to order by Board President, Rod Westfall. Mr. Westfall requested the roll to be called.

#### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

#### **CAPITAL PROJECTS DISCUSSION**

- A. Scope of Work The board discussed the scope of work as presented in the proposal from the Building Committee. Discussion revolved around reports from each home school's board and their response to the proposal. Also, discussion around the not to exceed amount of \$2,377,000. Summaries of board reports were given. Plainfield reported they accept the full scope of the proposal but will limit Plainfield's funding up to \$100,000 per year of the 10-yr. payout schedule. Valley View reported their board accepts the scope of work as presented. Lemont board supports the proposal and entrusted their representative to bargain in good faith the financial portion. Reed-Custer would like to see included a proposal that does not include the vehicle storage building. Wilmington reported their board had a good discussion and will support the scope of the proposal. ROE feels he should abstain from voting as he is not included in the repayment aspect of the project.
- B. Repayment Formula Reed-Custer Superintendent, Mark Mitchell, presented a repayment formula for consideration that he felt was more favorable to all the schools. The proposal did put Plainfield school district over \$100,000 repayment per year. Much discussion ensued. Lemont Representative, Gary Gray, suggested a modified version of Option E of the payout schedule where the excess over \$100,000 for Plainfield be divided equally between the other four (4) school districts. Option E is based on the 5 yr. average of fall housing (11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> graders) enrollment. Wilmington and Plainfield school district preferred repayment Option D, which combines (50%) a 5 yr. average of fall enrollment and (50%) EAV. The board came to a consensus of the modified option E which caps a school district's payments at \$100,000, with the excess over that amount to be divided equally between the remaining four (4) school districts. As part of the agreement, Wilco will contribute up to of \$300,000 to the project.

C. Dissolution Formula – The board wished to have further discussion on the dissolution formula and decided to continue the discussion and decision for the December 15, 2015 meeting.

### AC#1215-2535 – Capital Project, Scope of Work

It was moved by 365 and seconded by 209 to accept the scope of work as presented by the Building Committee.

## AC#1215-2536 - Capital Project, Repayment Formula

It was moved by 210 and seconded by 365 to approve the repayment formula, modified Option E, which is a 5 yr. average of fall housing (11<sup>th</sup> & 12) enrollment, and capping any school district at \$100,000 per year repayment. The amount in excess of \$100,000 that Plainfield District 202 would have to pay on this option (approx. \$34,519) to be divided equally between the remaining four (4) school districts.
