ASSISSTANT DIRECTOR/PRINCIPAL'S REPORT for May 15, 2018

Bosa Goodale, Assistant Director/Principal

- 1. Bosa discussed the updates, additions and changes to the student handbook.
- 2. Bosa reviewed the Wilco exit survey from the seniors. 78.77% of the seniors said they would continue on to college and 9.77% were undecided.
- 3. Bosa reported the teacher meeting on May 7th focused on Domain 4e and 1a Enhancements of Content and Knowledge of Pedagogical Skills, May 29th the focus was Domain 4 Compliance with School and District Regulations. She said they also have ongoing review of lesson plans with regards to goals, strengths and weaknesses.
- 4. Bosa was pleased to report to the board about Awards night on May 7th. There were 74 seniors in NTHS, 13 Juniors in NTHS, 19 Citizenship awards, 19 Students of the Year awards and 11 scholarships awarded, one to each high school and our Star Student scholarship presented to Haley Bachara from Plainfield South.
- 5. Bosa told the board the SkillsUSA state competition was complete and two Lockport students, Jaden Potete & Colin Gamagami took gold and qualified for Nationals competing in Interactive Application and Video Game Development.
