Bosa Goodale, Asst. Director/Principal

- 1. Bosa provided the board with a report on engagement of students. She reported there are 12 students that have not engaged at all.
- 2. Bosa thanked the Bolingbrook counselors who came in and did videos in different classrooms highlighting the Wilco programs.
- 3. Bosa informed the board there will be virtual open houses for all programs and the schedule is on the website. There will also be a virtual Counselor meeting on October 30th.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT for October 20, 2020 - Regular Meeting

Elizabeth Kaufman, Executive Director

- 1. <u>Finance and Facilities</u> Elizabeth reported the retractable wall in CNA/Game Design is completed. The additional welding booths are in and electrical is on hold. Elizabeth also told the board the Education Pathway grant is in and a detailed plan will be submitted in November to TREES. The literacy coach will be part of that grant. Elizabeth also informed the board that Workforce learning will depend on COVID and whether internships will be allowed.
- 2. <u>Curriculum</u> Elizabeth told the board we had a remote learning day on October 9th and she thanked Amanda Ramsden and Don Malec for their contribution to helping the staff.
- 3. <u>Leadership</u> Elizabeth informed the board the positions of Admin Asst. to Administration (Sybil) and IT Coordinator (Bob) have been posted. She plans to hire replacements in December to allow for training. Elizabeth told the board Wilco is included in a grant for Cybersecurity along with Lewis University and Joliet Junior College. Elizabeth thanked the home schools for the coordination of return schedules. She informed the board our staff planning committee will look at what 2nd semester might look like.
- 4. <u>Public Relations</u> Elizabeth shared with the board that Wilco staff had flu shots this month from Walgreens. Wilco also hosted Romeoville Fire Department for their pumping class and the

department said they would like to use our facilities several times a year. They told Elizabeth they are also looking at apprenticeships with their fire academy.
