

## **NEW STUDENT STEPS**

Visit the Admitted Students page at jjc.edu/admittedstudents for a complete list of steps to get started. Advising for new students is provided through the Student Advising Center.

STEP 1: Log in to MyJJC
<ul> <li>MyJJC is your one-stop-shop for access to important information like your class schedule, financial aid, deadlines and more.</li> </ul>
Your MyJJC account is created 24-72 hours after applying to JJC.
<ul> <li>Look up your MyJJC username, ID number, email and create your MyJJC password at jjc.edu/password.</li> </ul>
STEP 2: Make sure JJC has your placement records (if applicable)
<ul> <li>If you have a high enough ACT or SAT score, you may not need placement testing. If you took the ACT or SAT, you must make a request for the testing company to submit your scores to JJC.</li> <li>Your PSAT or high school GPA may also excuse you from placement testing. Check out our temporary alternative measures to see if you qualify at jjc.edu/placement.</li> <li>If you do not have any of these scores, you will need to take placement testing (see Step 6).</li> </ul>
STEP 3: Make sure JJC has your high school transcript or equivalency record
<ul> <li>The JJC Admissions Office must have your high school transcript or equivalency record, as well as all of your eligible test scores.</li> </ul>
Ask your high school to email these records to admissions@jjc.edu or mail them to: ATTN: Admissions, 1215 Houbolt Rd., Joliet, IL 60435
STEP 4: Submit earned college credit (if applicable)
<ul> <li>If you earned credit from another college or university, through Advanced Placement (AP) or through College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) credit, email your official college transcripts to transfercredit@jjc.edu.</li> <li>If you want your credits to be evaluated and added to your JJC record, you must complete a Transfer Credit Evaluation Form.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Placement scores are mandatory for enrollment into English, math and other classes.</li> <li>If you are not exempt (see Step 2), then you are required to take a JJC placement exam.</li> <li>Visit jjc.edu/testing or jjc.edu/placement to fill out a request form for testing.</li> </ul>
	STEP 7: Complete the FAFSA and apply for scholarships (if applicable)
	<ul> <li>Visit fafsa.edu.gov to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</li> <li>Visit jjc.edu/scholarships to apply for scholarships</li> </ul>

_	<ul> <li>In your virtual advisor meeting, you can discuss placement scores, your chosen program requirements, creating a class schedule, how to use JJC technology and how to register.</li> <li>Further instructions will be provided in the New Student Presentation located within MyJJC.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>If you didn't register for your first semester of classes during your advising session, you can do so on your own via MyJJC.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>STEP 10: Pay for classes (if applicable)</li> <li>Complete the Parent/Supporter Presentation at orientation.jjc.edu to learn about valuable student resources.</li> </ul>
